

Funeral Order of Service & Funeral Booklets

A Funeral Service Booklet or Funeral Order of Service Booklet may be offered as a keepsake to those who attend funeral and memorial services, or to send to those who could not attend the service. It is also a good idea to have extra copies for future generations.

The booklet content is up to you!

Here's some ideas to consider for a 4-page A5 booklet (A4 folded to A5).

Front Cover

What do you wish to call your booklet?

A Celebration of the Life of insert name
A Celebration of his/her Life insert name
In Loving Memory of insert name
Remembering insert name
One of a Kind insert name
Forever in our Hearts name
Name's hopes & dreams....interrupted

Photo

Date of Birth – Date of Death
Date, Place and Time of Funeral or Memorial Service

Back Cover

Photo/s, thankyous, location of wake, where donations can be made.

Inside

Order of service *(optional)*.

Ask your Funeral Celebrant for a list of headings. *Example:*

Entrance Music - Title and Musician

Welcome

Readings

Memories and Tributes

Photo Story / Visual Tributes / Memories

Reflection

Farewell

Recessional Music

Other inclusions - photos, verses, poems, favourite sayings, song lyrics.

COPYRIGHT - ensure author/s are acknowledged on required works



Tips

- Booklets are best printed on heavy stock card such as 250gsm stock.
- Spellcheck and proofread your content. Ask one or two other people to check before printing.
- Estimate the number of booklets required, including spare copies for family and close friends who cannot attend and keepsake copies for young members of your family
- Use easy to read fonts and type colours (hint little coloured type on white card is hard to read)
